## Dear Justice Kline:

We, the undersigned organizations and individuals, have a keen interest in ensuring access to the courts for incarcerated persons in California. We write in support of Mr. Foster's request for remote oral argument access. We urge this Court to issue an order to require the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to make incarcerated persons (like Mr. Foster) available to watch oral arguments in their cases.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, this Court has instituted remote oral arguments that, for more than a year now, have been accessible to members of the public via an internet link on the Court's website. Indeed, the implementation across the state of remote access to court proceedings for litigants during the pandemic has proven so successful that there is strong

support for maintaining extensive remote access to court proceedings even as pandemic regulations are withdrawn.

Given the relative ease with which such remote access is possible, this Court should embrace this shift in communication technology and take this opportunity to expand access to the courts by allowing state prisoners to remotely access the oral arguments in their pending cases.

Allowing state prisoners to remotely access oral argument in their pending cases would promote access to justice and facilitate greater participation, transparency, and trust in the criminal legal system for incarcerated individuals. It would increase fundamental fairness for those who have the most at stake in the outcome of their cases.

In August of this year, a Judicial Council workgroup that was convened to examine successful court practices adopted during the pandemic published an <a href="interim report">interim report</a><sup>1</sup> regarding remote access to courts. The report recommended that "California courts should expand and maximize remote access on a permanent basis" and that "the Judicial Council should encourage and support courts to substantially expand remote access through all available technology and should work to promote consistency in remote access throughout the state to ensure that Californians have equal access to the courts while providing flexibility to meet local needs."
